## 7 NIGHTS IN KOMODO NATIONAL PARK

LOCATED TO THE EAST OF BALI AND LOMBOK, KOMODO NATIONAL PARK IS A UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE, HOME TO THE LEGENDARY ENDEMIC KOMODO DRAGON AND ONE OF THE MOST SOUGHT-AFTER CRUISING GROUNDS IN INDONESIA.

Stretching east from Bali, you will find the islands of Lombok, Sumbawa, Moyo and Flores – each with a wealth of interesting sights above land. The famed islands of Komodo National Park are known for the endemic Komodo dragons, respected by locals who believe they descend from one born to a dragon princess centuries ago. Rolling hills and mangroves in the north give way to craggy mountainous terrain in the central region, while in the south, Horseshoe Bay is about as close as you can get to Jurassic Park with cliffs shrouded in cloud and the force of the Pacific Ocean pounding the coast outside the cove.

With an official count of more than 1,000 types of fish and 260 types of corals, the warm tropical waters of Komodo National Park are one of the most species-rich underwater environments on earth. One of the wonderful things about this underwater playground is that around 60% of its dive sites are also suitable for snorkelling with their shallow, fringing reefs. Surfers can explore the surrounding islands of Lombok, Sumbawa, Sumba and Rote for perfect waves.



#### DAY 1: LABUAN BAJO

You will be met at Labuan Bajo airport by the yacht's crew and transferred to the harbour, a 15-minute drive. Once you have settled in onboard, the yacht will depart from Labuan Bajo and cruise to the outskirts of the National Park while you enjoy lunch on deck. If time allows, go snorkelling or try a check dive before you watch the sun go down with a cocktail. Dinner will be served under the stars.







#### DAY 2: GILI LAWA LAUT

Today; the yacht will anchor on the northwestern edge of Komodo, near the Gili Lawa islands. These two islands are home to Komodo's most famous underwater sites including Castle Rock, Shotgun, The Passage and Lighthouse. Pitch up on a stretch of golden sand between underwater pursuits. A steep trek will reward you with stunning vistas over the surrounding islands, stretching into the distance.

#### DAY 3: PADAR ISLAND

Set between Rinca and Komodo, in the central region of the national park, lies the picturesque island of Padar. A sheltered bay on the southeast side of the island makes for a beautiful anchorage in the shadow of dramatic craggy peaks. Central Komodo's nutrient-rich waters attract shoals of schooling fish on current swept walls renowned as some of the best coral reefs in Indonesia. This bay is a wonderful spot to try watersports, relax on the beach or take a tender cruise into the mangroves to spot birdlife.







#### DAY 4: RINCA ISLAND

Lesser known than neighboring Komodo Island, Rinca is an excellent place to observe Komodo dragons, as well as the monkey population and an array of birdlife. This morning, stroll through the park with a ranger and catch sight of the famed Komodo dragons. This afternoon, submerge at underwater sites in the channel between Komodo and Flores, such as Tatawa Besar and Kecil, relax on a sandy beach flecked with shells or explore nearby coves and try some watersports.



#### DAY 5: SOUTH RINCA

South Rinca is home to Horse Shoe Bay (Nusa Kode), where fierce Komodo dragons patrol a beach backed by thick forest inhabited by monkeys, deer, wild boar and fish eagles. The landscape here is markedly different to that of central Komodo, with sheer peaks rising into whirls of cloud. Underwater spots here include macroheaven Cannibal Rock. This is an exciting area to take the tender out for a cruise along the dramatic rock formations.

#### DAY 6: MANTA POINT

Today, you will have a chance to visit a Manta cleaning station. Swim surrounded by Manta rays as they circle you in an underwater ballet. This area offers one of the most active underwater landscapes in Komodo with vibrant soft and hard coral gardens home to large numbers of fish. After lunch onboard, spend the afternoon beach combing or cruising mangroves and hidden coves on the tender, or relax onboard in the sunshine.

#### DAY 7: SEBAYOR

This morning, the yacht will arrive at Sebayor Island. This is a great spot for a relaxing castaway day; at Sebayor Kecil you can dive with black-tip reef sharks, groups of tuna, and green turtles diving from the surface. The afternoon can be spent enjoying watersports in quiet bays or reclining on a deserted sandy beach backed by the Komodo hills, as the day draws to a close with cocktails and dinner with a view over a final spectacular sunset.



#### DAY 8: LABYAN BAIO

Today the yacht will return to Labuan Bajo port. After a final decadent breakfast on deck, your crew will assist you in disembarking the yacht and transfer you back to the airport to catch your flight home.

# NORTH MALUKU

MALUKU (THE MOLUCCAS) IS AN ARCHIPELAGO CONSISTING OF OVER A THOUSAND ISLANDS, MORE THAN HALF OF WHICH ARE UNINHABITED. IT IS GENERALLY BELIEVED THAT THE NAME "MALUKU" IS DERIVED FROM JAZIRAT AL-MULUK, MEANING "ISLAND OF THE KINGS," AND THERE IS NO DOUBT A YACHT CHARTER THROUGH THIS REGION WILL MAKE YOU FEEL LIKE ONE YOURSELF.

Sitting between the pacific and the indian ocean, lapped by the Banda, Moluccan, Seram, Arafura, Timor Sea and Halmahera Seas, it is no wonder that if offers a wide range of sea life particular to this specific region.

The halmahera sea sits in the indonesian through-flow, catering divers with a medley of undiscovered sites while surfers can find solace in some truly sensational waves. From Maba Bay (the "Maldives" of Halmahera) to the welcoming village of Buho Buho, this historic 'spice trade' region boasts a great combination of sights and traditions for a well-rounded adventure.





#### DAY 1: KAO

You will be met at Kao airport by the yacht's crew and transferred to the harbour. Once you have settled in onboard, the yacht will depart the harbour and set sail towards North Maluku. Enjoy lunch onboard and cocktails at sunset. Dinner will be served under the stars.

#### DAY 2: TOBELO

Today you can enjoy island hopping around the Tobelo region and try surfing at some great warm up spots. There will also be a chance to get your check dives completed. For uncertified divers, you could try a Discover Scuba Diving experience to explore life beneath the waves.

#### DAY 3: WASILEO

After an overnight cruise, the yacht will arrive in the region of Wasileo. This coastline has some amazing surf spots and plenty of opportunities to dive and snorkel. In this area you will also find many white sand beaches that are perfect for a beach barbecue. Enjoy beach combing and relaxing on the sandy shorelines before the yacht heads south towards Tanjung Wayamli in the afternoon for some great


dive and surf spots. The yacht will cruise to Maba Bay overnight.


#### DAY 4 & 5: MABA BAY

This morning, the yacht will arrive in Maba Bay, dubbed the "Maldives" of Halmahera and one of the highlights of the region. Maba Bay has so much to offer: world class surf breaks, tiny inhabited white sand islands, colourful reefs for snorkelling and diving and great fishing, while on land there are lighthouses to explore. There is also the chance to encounter some of the local fishermen and see their hand made canoes and spear guns, and you may wish to try your hand at spearfishing.

#### DAY 6: MOROTAI

Morotai is a rugged, forested island lying to the north of Halmahera. It was under the reign of Ternate Kingdom in the 15-16th century, actually. Even though Portuguese dropped by on the island, they didn't stay for a long time due to the rejection of the local kingdom. Decades later, the World War II began and Japan took over the island before it was seized by the United States. The US Army built an air base there before the independence of Indonesia.
















#### DAY 7: BUHO BUHO

Buho Buho is home to an American NGO that is currently setting up a local surf community in the area and helping the community in their daily village life. This region is supremely remote and has not seen many visitors, so expect a beautiful village with extremely welcoming people who rely largely on coconut oil production. You can roam the big coconut tree plantations and learn about traditional production of cold pressed virgin coconut oil.

#### DAY 8: BERE BERE

This amazing island offers great diving, spear fishing and it is also home to one of the best waves in the Indo Pacific. In this area you might also want to take to a kayak or a paddleboard to explore the coast. You will also have an opportunity to visit "Dugongs", a beginner surf spot with a good chance of spotting the elusive marine mammal by the same name. The nearby villagers may invite us to go for a village walk and check out their local boat building yards, where traditional fishing boats are crafted by hand.









#### DAY 9: SOPI BAY

The yacht will continue heading north to SopiBay (depending on the swell and surf skill level of the guests) or alternatively to Batu Kopi beach. These two amazing surf regions are also among the top three in the Indo Pacific. The waves in Sopi Bay can be heavy, while Batu Kopi is more mellow and beginner/midrange friendly. Both areas also have great spear fishing and diving to offer, where you can expect to see huge giant trevallies, snappers, groupers and Spanish mackerels.

#### DAY 10: HALMA CHANNEL

Today the yacht will head south towards Tobelo, crossing the Halmahera and Morotai channel where you will have the opportunity to stop at some ship wrecks and airplane wreck dive sites or take to the waves on your surfboard. Enjoy sunset and relax on deck for your final evening.

#### DAY 11: KAO

This morning, the yacht will approach Kao harbour.

After a final decadent breakfast on deck, your crew will assist you in disembarking the yacht and transfer you back to the airport to catch your flight home.



### YACHT REFIT

A BEHIND-THE-SCENES OF WHY A YACHT REFIT IS IMPORTANT AND HOW IT'S DONE.



Yacht refits; it might sound like either a very abstract or a rather overwhelming undertaking to a (potential) yacht owner, yet it need not be either of those two. Let EXMAR Yachting's Xavier Ex take you behind the scenes to go into the 'why' and 'how' of it.

#### REFIT: THE WHY

In general, in order to maintain a yacht in perfect working condition, a thorough inspection is required every five years. Often, these extensive services translate into a mini-refit, as one might as well make the most of shipyard-time. Sometimes, a more thorough refit is either necessary or desired. Take Sailing Catamaran DOUCE FRANCE, for example.

Following a refit survey in Seychelles, where a clear outline of the extent of the refit was crafted with crew, owner, technical manager and shipyard

representatives, DOUCE FRANCE sailed to a shipyard in France. What's in a name, but there are more reasons to choose this location for its extensive refit; Europe tends to offer high-quality refits, France is relatively nearby for the owner and to EXMAR Yachting, who are the owner's representative and the ship managers, and it means that all parties are working in the same time zone. Xavier Ex, the owner's representative, explains: "Working in the same timezone is not an essential element to a successful refit, but it does make communication timelines more efficient. When you complete a refit in New Zealand, there is often a 12-hour delay for every phone call or email. Matching time zones allow for much quicker response times."

#### REFIT: THE WHAT

In case of DOUCE FRANCE, the largest portion of the refit meant a full repaint. Everything from topsides to masts, booms to buoys and hulls to davits was repainted, giving the catamaran a fresh new finish. Worth noting is that the colours and style of both





the paintworks as well as the interior were renewed without modification, as even after twenty years of ownership, the owner is still in love with his yacht as it is. Xavier: "Of course we upgraded the ship's systems wherever it was useful, but the overall design was and remains timeless to this day."

Speaking of upgrades, the inspection of the ship's structure from the inside of DOUCE FRANCE allowed for a thorough inspection on the inside. "She was completely open and dismantled, so we took full advantage," says Xavier. "Completely new crew cabins with improved lay-outs are being installed and the galley is receiving a full refit as well. The guest areas all received a full refurbishment, deliberately retaining its classic style. Even the insulation of the ship was renewed to match current standards, with better sound and thermal properties. There was a full upgrade on the ventilation, a redo of water- and air condition piping and part of the electricity was updated as well. No stone was left unturned."

#### **REFIT: LONG TERM VISION**

It is clear that a refit does not mean renewing for the sake of renewing. DOUCE FRANCE received a full EDCIS (professional IMO compliant digital charts system) upgrade, the communication system was completely renewed and upgraded, including a new, air-conditioned server rack and new modems/routers for 5G, wifi connection throughout the vessel and she is Starlink-ready. "It was decided to future-proof the vessel without letting ourselves get caught up with complex and redundant systems," says Xavier. "Often simple is more reliable, especially out in the open sea. That way, things are easier to repair on site if ever needed and spare parts are easy to find, making the ship easier to handle and cutting potential downtime."

Another deliberate choice in keeping the ship easy to handle, was keeping on the entire crew during the refit. Even during the shipyard period, logistics continue, and own crew can do so much more efficiently. Plus, it can be a really interesting period for the crew, according to Xavier: "Crew can learn new things, which adds to their personal development, but also makes them better crew on board their vessel in the long run. Keeping crew on board during downtime shows mutual loyalty and commitment, and it keeps knowledge on board."














#### REFIT: OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE

In DOUCE FRANCE's case, the shipyard period means that next to the crew itself, there is a dedicated project manager representing the Owner on board, who is responsible for monitoring the shipyard activities whilst the Captain of course remains responsible for safety of the ship and the crew's tasks. Xavier: "The both of them ensure the synergy between shipyard and crew, making sure they do not get in each other's way but reinforce each other where possible."

The two key figures act collaboratively on a problem-solving level, of course in close contact with the owner and Owner's Representative. "As Owner's Representative I have more decision-making rights. Also, the fact that I am not on board all the time makes that I bring a fresh perspective, which always helps with longer projects such as refits. As EXMAR Yachting, we are the main point of contact for the shipyard as

we represent multiple vessels, we are the point of contact for respective owners and the point of contact for personnel on board. Our voice carries more weight as a result."

Part of that weight is the fact that EXMAR Yachting has a direct line with the technical experts of the EXMAR Group. "It's why we have the broadest maritime knowledge of the entire yachting industry. We can lean on the broad in-house knowledge for specific suppliers and contractors, for example. EXMAR's purchase department also ensures that purchases are made properly, cost-effective, logistics done etc. We are a small team, so we're right on top of things ourselves. Combine that with the extensive, collective knowhow and you have a win/win situation."

The fully upgraded, nearly-new DOUCE FRANCE will be back in the water by summer, which is when she will be available for charter in the Mediterranean.




#### DAY 1 RIJEKA

#### DAY 2 - CRES



#### DAY 4 - OLIB - IST





#### DAY 5 - KORNATI

Kornati National Park is one of the most magical areas of Croatia, often named a 'nautical paradise' in tourist publications. Sail trough its 140 unforgettable islands, islets and reefs to test all of your nautical skills. The Kornati National Park covers the bigger part of the Kornati waters. Because of their exceptional landscape beauty, interesting geomorphology, and highly jagged and indented coast as well as because

Solta was a wealthy province of Split and the Roman Emperor Diocletian had his summer residence and a private fish farm here. Remains of Solta's Roman, Gothic and other historical periods are found throughout, but you need time to find them.


